

# Sentences issued – 1991

Darnell Garcia – 80 years; 5 years special parole. (Fine-\$1,065,000) Later reduced to 69 years by Court of Appeals (1994); reduced again in (1995) to 49 years; reduced again in (2003) to 41 years. Plead; not guilty.

John Jackson – 10 years; served 6 years 7 months. 5 years special parole. Released in 1996 (admitted at trial to selling over 150 kilos of heroin & cocaine) Plead; guilty.

Barbara Jackson – Probation  
(wife of John Jackson) Plead, guilty.

Wayne Countryman – 7 years; 5 years special parole (served less than 4 years) (admitted to selling over 50 kilos of cocaine) Plead, guilty.

Sherman Lair – One year home confinement sentence (Admitted to selling over 20 kilos of Cocaine for Jackson at trial) Plead, guilty.

Mahlon Stewart – No sentence, no probation, no fine (Admitted at trial to selling heroin and Cocaine for Jackson for several years.) Plead – unknown, professional informant for government.
